Who can come?

Who will be there?

The Washington State GSA Network has 10 unique regions. The goal is to have GSA leaders and adult GSA advisors from each region represented at our summer leadership training.

With the state broken up into regions, established GSA groups can help each other become stronger and help those GSA groups that have just started or are emerging.

These students will take active roles in their communities and will be available for trainings, assisting with the launch of new GSA groups, assisting established GSA groups, and to help plan and participate in community and regional events.

We will have adult chaperones who have undergone a Washington State Patrol background check. If you are interested in chaperoning please contact us.

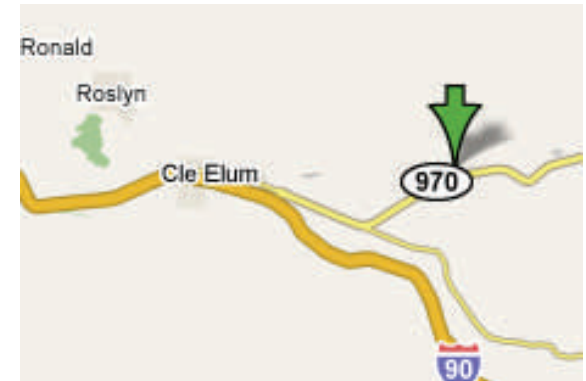
Where is it?
